Admission Policy For Pupils

- A pupil entering St. Martin of Tours School must first take the entrance test and display proficiency for the grade for which application is made.
- Pupils of families registered who are members and who regularly contribute to the parish will be given first preference.
- Students will be considered on merit and none denied admission because of race or national origin.
- Admission to Kindergarten and first grade will depend on READINESS, not CHRONOLOGICAL AGE.
- The selection of a student shall be determined by the pastor and principal.

NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY

SEX NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY – St. Martin of Tours Elementary School does not discriminate against any applicant or employee because of sex; and does not discriminate against any applicant or pupil because of sex in admissions, educational programs and activities.
